All our accommodation is professionally managed to meet ANZK Code of Standards.

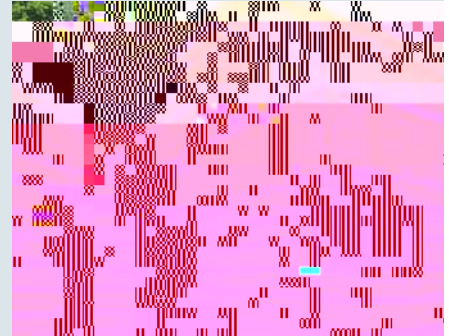

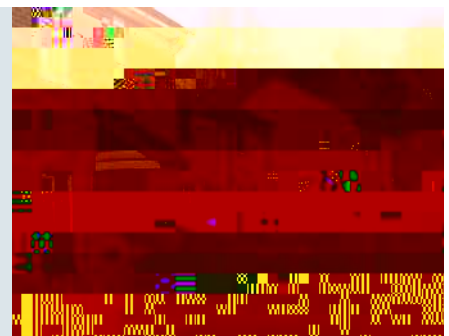

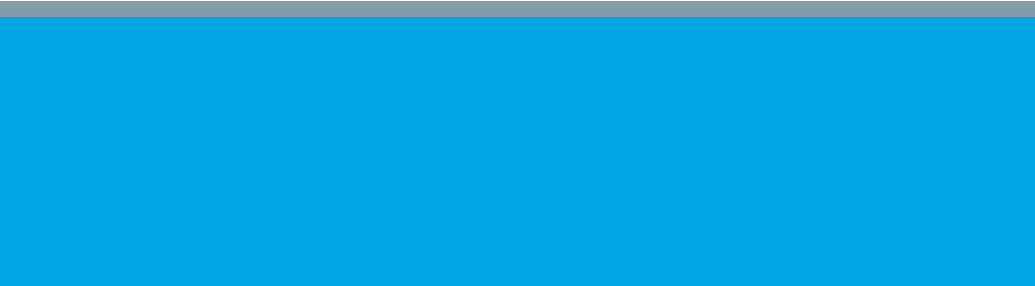
If you have been successful in applying for on-campus accommodation, you will be invited by the student union to provide you with the conditions of study and an average of an application or university-owned accommodation.
